



Winners of the Fishing Trip

Joe was the highest bidder of the guided fishing trip on the Turtle Flambeau Flowage in Northern Wisconsin that was part of the live auction at the NICC fishing derby and winter festival this past February. The trip was a two day trip for two people that was offered up the NICC Board Members and Wisconsin Licensed Guide Leonard Dane. The trip was claimed Saturday and Sunday of Memorial Day weekend. Although the weather was less than desirable, a good time was had by all. Joe brought his friend and good buddy Greg.

Day one started at about 7:00 in the morning. The group met at the Springstead boat ramp and after a short meet and greet departed in search of some fish. The group fished for about 5 hours with calm winds (too calm for fishing the TFF) and sporadic rain showers. The final straw for the day was a solid downpour. Joe and Greg said that they would rather not get any wetter and they all headed back to the boat ramp. They had caught two northern pike and a couple of smallmouth bass.

Day two began a little later with the group meeting at the same



boat ramp at 8:00. There was a nice southwest wind and Leonard knew the perfect spot to hit up. The fishing was much better with the wind and a lot more fish were caught, even though there were still an occasional rain shower. The group caught five walleyes ranging in size from 14 inches to 16.5 inches, about 10 rock bass, a good number of smallmouth bass and a couple of northern pike. At about 1:00 Joe and Greg decided to call the trip.

Both days the scenery was great and the wildlife was abundant. Eagles, loons and osprey as well as ducks and geese. Great conversation was had between everyone in the group and friendships were made.
