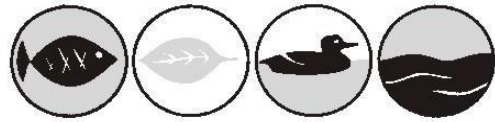

With this, they determined the need for education of hunters, fishermen, boaters, and campers of all ages.
