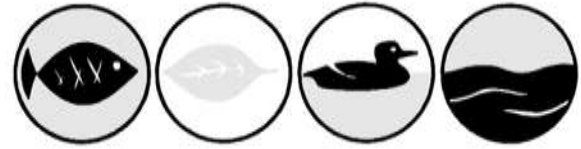


N.I.C.C.

All it took, was a message sent to membership that we had an urgent situation that required all hands on deck for Saturday April 13th from Noon to 4:00.

The creek that runs on the south side of our pond had debris, vegetation and growth that blocked the flow of water that runs through NICC property into Sequoit Creek. This blockage flooded our wetland to the south, and in turn is flooding our neighbors whose property abuts our wetland.

Leonard Dane, NICC president, met with Lake County Stormwater Management to review the survey analysis that was completed on this flooding issue. It was determined that the blockage in our creek needed to be restored by removing the debris, digging it a little bit deeper and removing one of our bridges while raising the other one. This will allow the water in our wetlands to flow towards Sequoit Creek.

Saturday morning arrived, and so did quite a few NICC volunteers. They worked like busy beavers cutting back all the brush along the creek and hauling it to a dumping area. The picture at the bottom of this page shows how the creek was cleared of debris and was widened a little.

The officers and directors of NICC, would like to thank all the dedicated volunteers for coming and working so hard on Saturday, April 13th.
